

The Early Bird card gives the cardholder only access to the outdoor gardens at the Montréal Botanical Garden from 6 to 9 a.m., seven days a week. There are no other privileges associated with the card.

The Early Bird card remains the property of the city of Montréal.

The Early Bird card may be used to enter the Montréal Botanical Garden only through the turnstiles located at:

- 4500 boul. Rosemont (north Garden entrance)
- 4581 Sherbrooke Est (entrance located near the Insectarium)
- 4101 Sherbrooke Est (east main entrance, near the ticket counter)

Other entrances, including the one near the La Jardinière restaurant, are not accessible with the Early Bird card and may not be used as exits.

The Early Bird card is valid for one year, starting on its issue or renewal date.

The Early Bird card is valid for one person only. It is not refundable, exchangeable or transferable. Under no circumstances may the holder of an Early Bird card bring any visitors who do not have their own Early Bird cards.

Early Bird cardholders visiting the Botanical Garden between 6 and 9 a.m. must show their cards to any authorized city of Montréal employee on request, at all times. Cardholders who are unable to do so will be asked to leave the site.

Failure to respect the rules in effect at the Montréal Botanical Garden, including trespassing in areas closed for phytosanitary treatment, may lead to the cancellation of the holder's Early Bird card, in which case it will not be renewable for a period of 48 months following the offence.

The Montréal Botanical Garden reserves the right to deactivate Early Bird cards during special events such as the Great Gardening Weekend.
