


The sky during the eclipse on April 8, 2024



The map represents the sky as it will appear from Southern Quebec during the solar eclipse of April 8, 2024. It shows the position of the brightest planets and stars that should be visible during totality, when the sky becomes dark enough. Planets Venus and Jupiter will be the easiest to see, above and below the eclipsed Sun, as well as bright stars Sirius and Capella. The visibility of other, fainter stars will depend on the viewing conditions at the time of the eclipse.
